**Homicides, shootings continued surge in March
Louisville's homicides in double digits for 14 straight months**

Gun violence continues surging in Louisville, with 16 homicides and 60 non-fatal shootings reported in Louisville Metro in March.

So far this year, 47 homicides and 159 non-fatal shootings have occurred, according to information provided by LMPD's homicide unit to Christopher 2X Game Changers.

"It's obvious from these numbers we have a public health crisis because of gun violence. Nobody thought it could be this bad," said 2X, Executive Director of the Game Changers organization who has been a non-violence advocate for more than two decades.

For 14 straight months Louisville has logged double-digit numbers of homicides which 2X said is "unbelievable."

"What is behind these numbers are real families and children suffering tremendously because of the losses," he said.

Louisville is on pace to break last year's homicide record. Louisville ended 2020 with a record 173 homicides. Non-fatal shootings also broke records last year, with 586 reported.

2X tracks shootings and homicides to draw attention to the problem. Through his organization, he provides guidance and support to families impacted by gun violence including helping with funerals and links to educational and other resources. His organization advocates for education and non-violence so that all children can reach their full potential.
